of his original appointment to the classified service, the employee is not entitled to any vacation leave or compensation for vacation leave. Subject to the exceptions of this subsection and excluding employees covered under collective bargaining agreements, every classified employee, unclassified employee, or appointed official, upon the termination of his State service, shall be entitled to receive a sum equivalent to one tenth of his established biweekly amount of compensation at the time his employment terminates, multiplied by the number of days of his earned and unused annual leave which was accumulated as of the end of the last calendar year preceding termination (subject to a maximum accumulation of [35] 45 working days) and the number of days of annual leave and no more than two 2 days compensatory leave earned and unused during the calendar year in which employment is terminated.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
