

(4) Except for any full-time or part-time faculty member at a State institution of higher education, any individual in an executive agency who, as determined by the Ethics Commission pursuant to Section 2-103(h), is charged, individually or as a member of the executive agency, with decision making authority or acts as a principal advisor to one with such authority in drafting specifications for, negotiating, or executing contracts which commit the State or any executive agency to expend in excess of \$10,000 per annum.

(5) Any member, appointee, or employee of the Maryland Stadium Authority.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
