(2) ANY Θ THER COMMISSIONS OR FEES PAID IN CONNECTION WITH THE OBLIGOR'S EMPLOYMENT.

- (a) The earnings withholding order sent to the obligor's employer shall:
- orders or pleadings; and
 - (2) include only the following information:
- obligor's earnings including explanation of the application of the Federal Consumer Credit Protection Act limits;
- (ii) that subject to further orders of the court, the employer is required to withhold the stated amount on a regular and continuing basis commencing on the beginning of the next pay period after receipt of the order;
- from the employee's [wages] EARNINGS an additional \$2 for each deduction made under the order;
- promptly to the support enforcement agency or to the recipient as specified in the order; and
- needs to comply with the earnings withholding order.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
