(b) The Commission may promulgate rules and regulations to enforce this section.-f-

CHAPTER 167

(Senate Bill 440)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Deputy Sheriffs - Oath

FOR the purpose of requiring deputy sheriffs in Charles County to subscribe to a certain oath; and generally relating to deputy sheriffs in Charles County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(c) (1) In addition to the oath or affirmation required under subsection (b) of this section, in St. Mary's County, every deputy sheriff shall take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation: "I, A.B., do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the United States of America and to the State of Maryland; that I will serve honestly and faithfully to uphold and defend the Constitution of the United
