

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 30A
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

30A.

(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.

(B) THERE IS A 7-DAY CLASS BDR (DELUXE RESTAURANT) (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE. THIS LICENSE MAY ONLY BE ISSUED FOR THE USE OF RESTAURANTS THAT:

(1) MEET THE DEFINITION REQUIREMENTS OF "RESTAURANT" ESTABLISHED UNDER THE REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS;

(2) HAVE A MINIMUM SEATING CAPACITY OF 150 PERSONS FOR DINING;

(3) HAVE A COCKTAIL LOUNGE OR BAR AREA SEATING CAPACITY NOT EXCEEDING 25 PERCENT OF THE SEATING CAPACITY FOR DINING;

(4) HAVE PARKING FACILITIES TO ACCOMMODATE A MINIMUM OF 75 VEHICLES; AND

(6) HAVE A MINIMUM CAPITAL INVESTMENT OF \$750,000, EXCLUSIVE OF THE COST OF THE LAND AND BUILDINGS.

(C) THIS LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED FOR USE IN AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS A FAST FOOD STYLE RESTAURANT.

(D) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THIS LICENSE IS \$1,000.

(E) (1) THIS LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE LOCATION SITE OF ITS FIRST ISSUANCE.

(2) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION DO NOT AFFECT A TRANSFER OF HOLDERS FOR THE SAME PREMISES OR A RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE.

(F) THIS LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ALL QUOTA PROVISIONS PROVIDED UNDER § 47A OF THIS ARTICLE.
