

CHAPTER 186

(Senate Bill 924)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore and Harford Counties - Hunting and Trapping
Muskrat and Mink

FOR the purpose of altering the season during which a person may hunt or trap muskrat or mink in Baltimore County and Harford County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Natural Resources
Section 10-406(b)(1)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1983 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-406.

(b) (1) (i) A person may possess any green pelt of any fur-bearing mammal until March 25 for purposes of curing the skins.

(ii) However, in Frederick, Garrett, Allegany, Carroll, Howard, and Washington counties, a person may hunt or trap mink or muskrat between November 15 and February 15, of the year following, and a person may possess any green mink and muskrat pelt until February 25 for purposes of curing the skin.

(iii) 1. In the remainder of the State except for the counties in item 2. of this paragraph, a person may hunt or trap mink or muskrat between January 1 and March 15.

2. In BALTIMORE, Cecil, HARFORD, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, and Worcester counties, a person may hunt or trap mink or muskrat between December 15 and March 15 of the year following.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987.
