(b) (1) The Council shall adopt regulations for all correctional institutions in the Division of [Corrections] CORRECTION for the implementation of a mandatory education program for all inmates who fail to attain a minimum educational standard as set forth in this subsection.

(2) The regulations adopted by the Council shall require that:

(iii) Any inmate who is not exempted under [paragraph 3. of subparagraph (ii)] SUBPARAGRAPH (II)3. of this subsection shall participate in the mandatory education program for at least 90 calendar days.
