The Commission shall require each facility to give the Commission information that:

- (1) Concerns the total financial needs of the facility;
- (2) Concerns its current and expected resources to meet its total financial needs;
- (3) Includes the effect of any proposal [made] MADE, under Subtitle 1 of this title, on comprehensive health planning; and
- (4) Includes physician information sufficient to identify practice patterns of individual physicians across all facilities. The names of individual physicians are confidential and are not discoverable or admissible in evidence in a civil or criminal proceeding, and may only be disclosed to the following:
- (i) The utilization review committee of \hat{a} Maryland hospital;
- (ii) The Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of the State of Maryland;
 - (iii) The State Board of Medical Examiners; or
- (iv) The Commission on Medical Discipline of Maryland.
