- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Home-based hospice care program" means a program that directly or through a contractual arrangement provides a hospice care program in the residence of the patient.
 - (c) "Hospice facility" means a facility that:
 - (1) Provides a hospice care program;
 - (2) Is separate from any other facility; and
 - (3) Admits at least 2 individuals who:
 - (i) Are unrelated; AND
 - (ii) Have no reasonable prospect of a cure[;

- (iii) Are expected to die within 6 months]:
- (d) "General hospice care program" means a coordinated, interdisciplinary program of hospice care services for meeting
