(a) (1) Except as provided in [the Administrative Procedure Act] TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE and in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, and unless it is renewed for another term, a license expires 1 year from the date of issuance or renewal or as provided by local law, ordinance, or regulation in accordance with [§ 4-304(b) and (c)] § 21-304 (B) AND (C) of this subtitle.

(2) Except as provided in [the Administrative Procedure Act] TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, and unless it is renewed for another term, a license to operate a crab meat plant expires on April 1 of each year.

(3) Except as provided in [the Administrative Procedure Act] TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, and unless it is renewed for another term, a license to operate a shellfish plant expires on August 31 of each year.
