AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all persons who are, as of July 1, 1987, classified employees of the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and whose positions are transferred to the Department of the Environment by this Act are hereby transferred to the Department of the Environment, effective July 1, 1987, without any change or loss of rights or status, and shall retain their merit system and retirement system status, except as otherwise specifically provided in this Act.
