otherwise affect law that is the subject of other acts, whether those acts were signed by the Governor prior to or after the signing of this Act.

SECTION $-\frac{1}{2}$, AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and Sections 1 and 3 through $-\frac{1}{2}$ shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

SECTION -14:- 16. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 7

(Senate Bill 88)

AN ACT concerning

Racing - Intertrack Wagering

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Racing Commission to establish a system of intertrack wagering between mile thoroughbred tracks and to authorize intertrack wagering if approval is given by certain tracks and organizations; requiring intertrack wagering to be done on the premises of a certain track; providing for the allocation of the intertrack wagering mutuel pools, the transmission and use of pari-mutuel information, and the jurisdiction of Commission; requiring the track conducting the racing to transmit a live simulcast of each race; providing for the construction of this Act concerning wagering at the sending track and certain track employees; requiring the Commission to adopt certain regulations; requiring the Commission to make a certain report each year to the General Assembly; requiring approval by the General Assembly before certain regulations may be adopted or certain other regulations may be proposed by the Commission; defining certain terms; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to intertrack wagering on thoroughbred horse races in the State.
