

Any excess remaining on June 30, 1989 shall revert to the general fund.

Further provided that funds appropriated in subobject B04 for service of process may be expended for that purpose only and may not be transferred to any other purpose by budget amendment or otherwise. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the district court pay sheriff's fees for service of process only through December 31, 1988 and that payment for service of process shall be made directly to sheriffs as of January 1, 1989. The district court may assist sheriffs in preparing to directly receive payment for service of process.....
