- (b) (1) The term of an appointed member is 5 years.
- (2) The terms of appointed members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Authority on July 1, 1980.
- (3) At the end of a term, an appointed member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (c) The Governor may remove an appointed member at the Governor's pleasure.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 13

(Senate Bill 102)
