Article - State Government Section 10-107 Annotated Code of Maryland (1984 Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

10-107.

- (A) "UNIT COUNSEL" MEANS THE UNIT COUNSEL FOR THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION, THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, AND THE STATE ETHICS COMMISSION.
- (B) Unless a proposed regulation is submitted to the Attorney General OR TO THE UNIT COUNSEL for approval as to legality, the regulation:
- (1) may not be adopted under any statutory authority; and
 - (2) if adopted, is not effective.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
