CHAPTER 20

(Senate Bill 121)

AN ACT concerning

Professional Land Surveyors and Property Line Surveyors - Application Fees

FOR the purpose of altering the application fee for persons applying to become a licensed professional land surveyor; altering the application fee for persons applying to become a licensed property line surveyor, and generally relating to the licensure of land surveyors.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 56 - Licenses Section 336(a) and (b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1983 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

336.

- (a) The registration fee for professional land surveyors is [\$50] \$135, of which [\$20] \$105 shall accompany the application, and \$30 shall be paid on issuance of the certificate.
- (b) (1) Before July 1, 1990, the registration fee for a property line surveyor is [\$35] \$100, of which [\$15] \$80 shall
