- (f) [One dollar (\$1.00)] \$1 for temporary license.
- (q) To renew a certificate, a manicurist:
- (1) Need only pay the renewal fee under subsection (b) of this section; and
- (2) Is not required to pay the beauty shop owner fee under subsection (a) of this section when practicing his or her profession in a licensed barbershop.
- (h) [Five dollars (\$5.00)] \$5 for students, valid for 5 years from the year of issuance.

The above fees for registration, examination and certification shall be paid in advance to the secretary of the Board.

- (a) Upon payment of [\$20] \$100, the Board shall register each applicant who satisfactorily passes the examination and shall issue to the applicant a certificate of registration.
- SECTION 2.
