SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

432A.

(A) AN ASSISTANT BARBER LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ENGAGE IN LIMITED PRACTICES OF BARBERING:

(1) FOR COMPENSATION;

(2) UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED MASTER BARBER IN A LICENSED BARBERSHOP; AND

(3) RESTRICTED TO:

(I) SHAMPOOING;

(II) THE REMOVAL OF HAIR SOLUTIONS;

(III) THE STERILIZATION OF EQUIPMENT; AND

(IV) SIMILAR ACTIVITIES.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE AN ASSISTANT BARBER LICENSE TO ANY QUALIFIED PERSON WHO:

(1) IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE; AND

(2) PAYS THE LICENSE FEE.

(C) AN ASSISTANT BARBER LICENSE EXPIRES ON ~~THE SECOND~~ MAY 31 OF EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED.
