(G) (1) A CLASS 6 BALTIMORE CITY PUB-BREWERY LICENSE SHALL BE ISSUED:

(II) ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE) LICENSE THAT IS ISSUED FOR USE ON THE PREMISES OF A RESTAURANT LOCATED IN BALTIMORE CITY.
