- (a) (1) The Commission consists of 9 members appointed by the Charles County Commissioners.
 - (2) Of the 9 [board] members:
- Group; (i) 1 shall be designated by the Black History
- (ii) 1 shall be designated by the Historical Society of Charles County;
- Indian Tribe; (iii) 1 shall be designated by the Piscataway
- (iv) 1 shall be designated by the Society for the Restoration for Port Tobacco;
- (v) 1 shall be designated by the Committee for the Restoration of the Dr. Samuel A. Mudd House; Inc.;
- (vi) 1 shall be designated by the President of the Charles County Community College or an appointed representative; and
- $({\rm vii})$ 3 shall be members appointed at large by the county commissioners.
- (b) (l) The term of a member of the Commission is [3] 4 years;
- [(2) The term of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Commission on July 1, 1982;
- [(3)](2) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed;
- [(4)] (3) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Commission on July 1, 1988.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
