(D) BOARD.

"BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

No changes are made.

(E) CONSTRUCTION.

- (1) "CONSTRUCTION" MEANS THE PROCESS OF BUILDING, ALTERING, IMPROVING, OR DEMOLISHING AN IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY.
- (2) "CONSTRUCTION" INCLUDES ANY MAJOR WORK NECESSARY TO REPAIR, PREVENT DAMAGE TO, OR SUSTAIN EXISTING COMPONENTS OF AN IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY.
- (3) "CONSTRUCTION" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE MAINTENANCE OR ROUTINE OPERATION OF AN EXISTING IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former SF § 11-101(i).

In this subsection, the former references to "structure[s]" and "building[s]" are deleted as included in the references to "improvement to real property".

In paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, the term "construction" is substituted, as the defined term, for the former word "repairing", for clarity. The former word "repairing" appeared only once, in former SF \$ 11-101(i)(1), now paragraph (1) of this subsection.
