## (F) CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES.

"CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES" MEANS FEASIBILITY STUDIES, SURVEYS, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION, AND OTHER SIMILAR EFFORTS ASSOCIATED WITH CONSTRUCTION OR THE ACQUISITION OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AS DEFINED IN § 4-401(D) OF THIS ARTICLE.

## (G) COUNTY.

"COUNTY" MEANS A COUNTY OF THE STATE AND, UNLESS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE, BALTIMORE CITY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to indicate that a reference in this Division II to "county" includes Baltimore City, unless the reference specifically provides otherwise.

Art. 1, § 14(a) of the Code provides that "county" includes Baltimore City "unless such construction would be unreasonable". However, the word "unreasonable" in that subsection has been interpreted in various ways. Therefore, a more explicit definition of "county" is included in this Division II.

## (H) ENGINEERING SERVICES.

- (1) "ENGINEERING SERVICES" MEANS PROFESSIONAL OR CREATIVE WORK THAT:
- (I) IS PERFORMED IN CONNECTION WITH ANY UTILITY, STRUCTURE, BUILDING, MACHINE, EQUIPMENT, OR PROCESS; AND
- (II) REQUIRES ENGINEERING EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE IN THE APPLICATION OF SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE OF THE MATHEMATICAL, PHYSICAL, AND ENGINEERING SCIENCES.
- (2) "ENGINEERING SERVICES" INCLUDES CONSULTATION, INVESTIGATION, EVALUATION, PLANNING, DESIGN, AND INSPECTION OF CONSTRUCTION TO INTERPRET AND ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH
