(A) "COUNCIL" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "COUNCIL" MEANS THE PROCUREMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL.

(B) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A PROCUREMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL.

(C) COMPOSITION.

THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 7 MEMBERS:

- (1) THE STATE TREASURER;
- (2) THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND;
- (3) THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING;
- (4) THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES;
- (5) THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION;
- (6) THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD; AND
- (7) A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

(D) CHAIRMAN.

THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD IS CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL.

(E) MEETINGS.

THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR.

(F) STAFF.

THE COUNCIL SHALL HAVE THE STAFF THAT THE BOARD AUTHORIZES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

(G) POWERS AND DUTIES.

~~ON-ITS-OWN-INITIATIVE, THE COUNCIL MAY AND, AS DIRECTED BY THE BOARD, THE COUNCIL SHALL CONDUCT STUDIES, RESEARCH, AND ANALYSES ON MATTERS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD.~~
