TITLE 14. PREFERENCES.

SUBTITLE 1. PREFERENCES TO BENEFIT DISADVANTAGED INDIVIDUALS.

14-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE \cdot FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) SHELTERED WORKSHOP.

"SHELTERED WORKSHOP" MEANS AN AGENCY THE-NET-INCOME-OF-WHICH DOES-NOT-INURE-WHOLLY-OR-PARTLY-TO-THE-BENEFIT-OF-ANY-SHAREHOLDER OR-OTHER-INDIVIDUAL-AND-THAT-IS:

- (1) $\overline{\text{THAT IS}}$ ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES OR THE STATE;
- (2) THAT IS CERTIFIED AS A SHELTERED WORKSHOP BY THE WAGE AND HOUR DIVISION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR;
- (3) THAT IS ACCREDITED BY THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; AND
- (4) THAT IS OPERATED IN THE INTEREST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE A MENTAL OR PHYSICAL DISABILITY, INCLUDING BLINDNESS, THAT:
- (I) CONSTITUTES A SUBSTANTIAL HANDICAP TO EMPLOYMENT; AND
- (II) PREVENTS THE INDIVIDUAL FROM ENGAGING IN NORMAL COMPETITIVE EMPLOYMENT-: AND
- PARTLY TO THE BENEFIT OF ANY SHAREHOLDER OR OTHER INDIVIDUAL.
