14-202. SCOPE OF PROGRAM.

THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO PROCUREMENT OF SUPPLIES, SERVICES, AND CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES BY:

- (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES;
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND
- (3) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former SF § 11-140(a)(2) and the first sentence of (d).

The requirements of former SF § 11-140 applied to a "Secretary", which was defined to mean "the Secretary of General Services, the Secretary of Transportation, or the President of the University of Maryland". Thus, the definition of the word "Secretary" limited the application of the small business preference program. This limitation is set forth as a separate scope provision for emphasis.

14-203. QUALIFIED BUSINESSES.
