

(1) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, EACH DESIGNATED UNIT SHALL REPORT:

(I) TO THE BOARD;

(II) TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS; AND

(III) SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE.

(2) A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL STATE FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR:

(I) THE TOTAL NUMBER AND VALUE OF PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE DESIGNATED UNIT AND CERTIFIED MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES; AND

(II) THE PERCENTAGE THAT THOSE PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS REPRESENT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER AND VALUE OF PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS.

(B) INFORMATION FROM OTHER UNITS.

WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, EACH UNIT THAT IS NOT REQUIRED TO REPORT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL SEND TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS:

(1) TO THE EXTENT AVAILABLE, THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION; AND

(2) A STATEMENT OF THE STEPS THAT THE UNIT HAS TAKEN TO CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 14-302(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former SF § 11-148(c)(1) and (2)(i).

The introductory language of subsection (a)(2) of this section is revised so that the phrase "for the preceding fiscal year" applies to subsection (a)(2)(i) and (ii). In former SF § 11-148(c)(1), it was unclear whether the phrase applied only to the provisions revised in subsection (a)(2)(ii) of this section or both subsection (a)(2)(i) and (ii).
