~~(1)~~ (1) WAS EXEMPT FROM THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS OF § 13-103(C) OF THIS ARTICLE BECAUSE THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER REASONABLY EXPECTED THAT ~~NO--PART--OF~~ THE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT WOULD BE PERFORMED WITHIN THE ENTIRELY OUTSIDE THIS STATE OR AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA;

~~(2)~~ (2) COST MORE THAN \$100,000 AND WAS AWARDED FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES, CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES, ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES, OR ENGINEERING SERVICES; OR

~~(3)~~ (3) WAS AWARDED ON THE BASIS OF:

1- (I) § 13-107 ["SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT"]; OR

2- (II) § 13-108(A) ["EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT"]; OR

3- (III) § 13-108(B) ["EXPEDITED PROCUREMENT"].

(B) SAME -- CONTENTS.

(1) A REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)~~(1)~~~~(2)~~ (2) OR ~~(3)~~ (3) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

(I) THE NAME OF EACH CONTRACTOR;

(II) THE TYPE AND COST OF THE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT; AND

(III) A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCUREMENT.

(2) A REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)~~(1)~~~~(2)~~ (3) OF THIS SECTION ALSO SHALL DESCRIBE THE BASIS FOR THE AWARD.

(C) REPORT BY GOVERNOR.

WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A REPORT ON EACH EXPEDITED PROCUREMENT APPROVED UNDER § 13-108(B) OF THIS ARTICLE.

(D) REPORT BY DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING.

WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A REPORT ON EACH CLASS OF
