15-207. MEMBERSHIP.

(A) COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

THE APPEALS BOARD CONSISTS OF 3 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS.

EACH MEMBER OF THE APPEALS BOARD SHALL:

- (1) BE QUALIFIED TO SERVE IN A QUASI-JUDICIAL CAPACITY; AND
- (2) HAVE A THOROUGH KNOWLEDGE OF PROCUREMENT PRACTICES AND PROCESSES.

BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, EACH APPOINTEE TO THE APPEALS BOARD SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.
