TITLE 16. DEBARMENT OF CONTRACTORS.

SUBTITLE 1. DEBARMENT FOR OFFENSES OTHER THAN BRIBERY.

16-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) CONVICTION.

"CONVICTION" INCLUDES AN ACCEPTED PLEA OF NOLO CONTENDERE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as SF § 11-211(a)(3).

No changes are made.

(C) STATE CONTRACT.

"STATE CONTRACT" MEANS A CONTRACT WITH A UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former SF § 11-211(a)(5).

The former reference to a contract "of any kind" is deleted as unnecessary since an unqualified reference to "a contract" means a contract of any kind.
