

(I) THE TRADE, CRAFT, OR OCCUPATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS LEARNING; AND

(II) THE PERIOD--AT-WHICH BEGINNING AND ENDING DATES OF THE APPRENTICESHIP BEGINS-AND-ENDS; AND

(3) IS REGISTERED IN A PROGRAM OF THE COUNCIL OR THE BUREAU OF APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

(C) COMMISSIONER.

"COMMISSIONER" MEANS:

- (1) THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY;
- (2) THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY; OR
- (3) AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COMMISSIONER.

The specific reference to the "Deputy Commissioner of Labor and Industry" is substituted for the former vague reference to "his duly authorized deputy", for clarity.
