SUBTITLE 3. STEEL PROCUREMENT FOR PUBLIC WORKS.

17-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as SF § 12-401(a).

(B) AMERICAN STEEL PRODUCT.

"AMERICAN STEEL PRODUCT" MEANS A PRODUCT THAT IS:

(1) PRODUCED FROM STEEL MADE IN ANY STATE BY THE OPEN HEARTH, BASIC OXYGEN, ELECTRIC FURNACE, BESSEMER, OR OTHER STEEL MAKING PROCESS; AND

(2) ROLLED, FORGED, DRAWN, CAST, EXTRUDED, OR OTHERWISE SIMILARLY PROCESSED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former SF § 12-401(d) and (e). It is revised to incorporate the terms "United States" and "steel products", which were set out in the former law as separate defined terms.

The term "American steel product" is substituted, as the defined term, for the former term "steel
