17-302. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT APPLY IF THEY CONFLICT WITH A FEDERAL LAW OR GRANT AFFECTING A CONTRACT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first clause of former SF § 12-404.

The word "law" is substituted for the former word "regulation", to encompass Congressional legislation that affects a contract. The Procurement Revision Review Committee calls this substitution to the attention of the General Assembly.

17-303. AMERICAN STEEL PRODUCTS REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, A PUBLIC BODY SHALL REQUIRE A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR TO USE OR SUPPLY ONLY AMERICAN STEEL PRODUCTS IN THE PERFORMANCE OF A CONTRACT FOR:

- (1) CONSTRUCTING OR MAINTAINING A PUBLIC WORK; OR
