## CHAPTER 66

(House Bill 197)

AN ACT concerning

Agricultural Liming Materials and Gypsum Law - Sample Results

FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the Secretary of Agriculture publish certain results under the Agricultural Liming Materials and Gypsum Law.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Agriculture Section 6-304 Annotated Code of Maryland (1985 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Agriculture

6-304.

- (a) The Secretary may collect samples of agricultural liming materials and gypsum to have them analyzed [and shall publish the results for public information].
- (b) The Secretary has full access, ingress, and egress to and from any place of business, any quarry, kiln, factory, barn, building, land, or vessel used for manufacturing, storing, transporting, or selling agricultural liming materials or gypsum. The Secretary may open any container or package containing or supposed to contain agricultural liming material or gypsum and take any sample for analysis.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
