SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-1503.

(a) The members of the Council are:

(1) the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Secretary's designee;

(2) the Secretary of Human Resources or the Secretary's designee;

(3) the State Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's designee;

(4) the Director of the Governor's Office for [the Coordination of Services to the] Handicapped INDIVIDUALS, as a nonvoting, ex officio member; [and]

(5) the Director of the Office for Children and Youth, as a nonvoting, ex officio member; AND

(6) THE DIRECTOR OF THE JUVENILE SERVICES AGENCY OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE.

(b) (1) There is a chairman of the Council who shall serve a term of 12 months in [3] 4-year cycles of rotation as provided in this subsection.

(2) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene is the chairman of the Council for a term of 12 consecutive months beginning on July 1, 1987. The Secretary of Human Resources shall succeed the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene as chairman for a term of 12 consecutive months, [and] the [State Superintendent of Schools] DIRECTOR OF THE JUVENILE SERVICES AGENCY shall succeed the Secretary of Human Resources for a term
