CHAPTER 69

(House Bill 217)

AN ACT concerning

Commission on Afro-American History and Culture

FOR the purpose of altering a duty of the Commission on Afro-American History and Culture from coordinating the participation of black groups in the American bicentennial observance to coordinating the observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday; and generally relating to the Commission on Afro-American History and Culture and observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 41B - Department of Housing and Community
Development
Section 5-303
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1986 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 41B - Department of Housing and Community Development
5-303.

The Commission shall:

(1) Initiate, direct, and coordinate projects which further the understanding of black history and culture;

(2) Continue the survey of historic buildings, sites, artifacts, archives and repositories, and publish and disseminate these findings and information;
