SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

9-503.

- Each county shall have a county plan that:
 - Is approved by the Department;
- (2) Covers at least the 10-year period next following adoption by the county governing body; and
 - (3) Deals with:
 - (i) Water supply systems;
 - (ii) Sewerage systems;
 - (iii) Solid waste disposal systems;
 - (iv) Solid waste acceptance facilities; and
- (v) The systematic collection and disposal of solid waste, including litter.
- (b) Except as provided in § 9-515 of this subtitle, county governing body shall review its county plan at least once every 2 years in accordance with a schedule set by the Department.
