CHAPTER 102

(House Bill 1277)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County Memorial Library System -Board Members PG 406-88

FOR the purpose of repealing the limitation on the number of consecutive terms of office a board member of the Prince George's County Memorial Library System may serve.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education Section 23-303(c) Annotated Code of Maryland --(1985 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

23-303.

- (c) (l) Each member of a board serves for a term of 5 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on the board as of July 1, 1978.
- (2) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A member may be reappointed but may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
- (3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MEMORIAL LIBRARY SYSTEM MAY SERVE AN UNLIMITED NUMBER OF CONSECUTIVE TERMS OF OFFICE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
