(v) a truck that:

- has 2 axles;
- 2. is combined with a freight trailer or semitrailer, as described in § 13-927(c) of the Transportation Article; and
- operating gross combination weight of more than 40,000 pounds.]
 ANY MOTOR VEHICLE USED OR MAINTAINED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY THAT:
- GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT THAT EXCEEDS 26,000 POUNDS;

(II) HAS 3 OR MORE AXLES; OR

VEHICLE AND HAS AN OPERATING OR REGISTERED GROSS COMBINED WEIGHT THAT EXCEEDS 26,000 POUNDS.

- (2) "Commercial motor vehicle" does not include:
 - (i) a privately owned antique truck that:
