

(2) Reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(d) The Commission may maintain an office in this State.

(e) The Commission may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget. The Commission may designate one of its staff as an executive director.

(f) The Commission shall be assigned an Assistant Attorney General by the Attorney General to assist in the investigation, development, and prosecution of cases referred to the Commission.]

In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Commission shall:

(1) Adopt rules and regulations for:

(i) The conduct of its business; and

(ii) The proper supervision and control of the professional conduct of the persons under its jurisdiction; and

(2) Submit an annual report to the Secretary, the Board, and the Faculty.]
