

(ii) However, if the investigatory body does not complete its report within 90 days, the [Commission] BOARD ~~may refer the allegation to another investigatory body~~ SHALL COMPLETE THE INVESTIGATION MAY REFER THE ALLEGATION TO ANOTHER INVESTIGATORY BODY.

(2) The report shall contain the information and recommendations necessary for appropriate action by the [Commission] BOARD.

(3) On receipt of the report, the [Commission] BOARD shall consider the recommendations made in the report and take the action, including further investigation, that it finds appropriate under this title.

(e) (1) To facilitate the investigation and prosecution of disciplinary matters coming before it, the [Commission] BOARD may:

(i) Contract with the Faculty, its committees, and the component medical societies for the purchase of investigatory and related services; and

(ii) Contract with others for the purchase of investigatory and related services and make these services available to the Faculty, its committees, and the component medical societies.

(2) Services that may be contracted for under this subsection include the services of:

- (i) Investigators;
- (ii) Attorneys;
- (iii) Accountants;
- (iv) Expert witnesses; and
- (v) Consultants.

(f) The [Commission] BOARD may issue subpoenas and administer oaths in connection with any investigation under this section and any hearing or proceeding before it.

(g) Those individuals not licensed under this title but covered under § 14-512(a)(1)(iii) and (iv) of this subtitle are subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-505 of this subtitle.

(H) (1) IT IS THE INTENT OF THIS SECTION THAT THE DISPOSITION OF EVERY COMPLAINT AGAINST A LICENSEE THAT SETS FORTH ALLEGATIONS OF GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION FILED WITH THE BOARD SHALL BE COMPLETED WITHIN--6 MONTHS AS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS
