

(c) On suspension or revocation of any license, the holder shall surrender the license certificate to the Board.

(d) At the end of the suspension period, the Board shall return to the licensee any license certificate surrendered under this section.

(e) The Board [and the Commission each] shall keep a copy of the order of suspension or revocation as a permanent record.

14-508.

(a) Except as provided in this section for an action under § 14-504 of this subtitle, any person aggrieved by a final decision of the [Commission] BOARD in a contested case, as defined in the Administrative Procedure Act, may:

(1) Appeal that decision to the Board of Review; and

(2) Then take any further appeal allowed by the Administrative Procedure Act.

(b) (1) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the [Commission] BOARD under § 14-504 of this subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary or Board of Review but may take a direct judicial appeal.

(2) The appeal shall be made as provided for judicial review of final decisions in the Administrative Procedure Act.

(c) An order of the [Commission] BOARD may not be stayed pending review.

(d) The [Commission] BOARD may appeal from any decision that reverses or modifies its order.

14-509.

(a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, the Board may reinstate the license of an individual whose license has been suspended or revoked under this title only in accordance with:

(1) The terms and conditions of the order of suspension or revocation;

(2) An order of reinstatement issued by the [Commission] BOARD; or

(3) A final judgment in any proceeding for review.

(b) An individual whose license has been suspended or revoked under this title and who seeks reinstatement shall meet
