AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) ~~10-307(d) through (g)~~, 10-804(c), 13-403, 13-404, and 13-406 through 13-414, respectively, of the Tax - General Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1988) be renumbered to be Section(s) ~~10-307(e) through (f)~~, 10-804(d) 10-804(e), 13-404, 13-405, and 13-407 through 13-415, respectively.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in accordance with Section 2 of Chapter 700 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1987, which enacted Article 81, § 411-I to remain effective for 2 years and to be abrogated at the end of June 30, 1989, Section(s) 9-603 of Article 24 -- Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1988) be repealed effective July 1, 1989. If, however, the General Assembly extends either Article 81, § 411-I or Article 24, § 9-603, this Section shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
