## LAWS OF MARYLAND

Reference, the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall propose the correction of cross-references that are rendered incorrect by this Act.

SECTION 1. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1989, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1988 (S.B. 1), and if Chapter does not become effective, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

## CHAPTER 111

(Senate Bill 44)

AN ACT concerning

Voting Machines - Educational Institutions

FOR the purpose of authorizing a local board of supervisors of elections to rent or lease voting machines to any educational institution for use in certain elections or votes on referendums.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 33 - Election Code Section 16-1(d) Annotated Code of Maryland (1986 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

16-1.

(d) The boards in the counties shall have the power to rent or lease voting machines to any EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, municipal corporation, special tax area, or other political subdivision in that county, for use in any election or referendum vote in [such] THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, municipal corporation, special tax area, or other political subdivision. The rental or lease shall be on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the board. The board shall account for and pay
