CHAPTER 113

(Senate Bill 87)

AN ACT concerning

Privileged Communications - News Media

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person, employed by the news media in any news gathering or news disseminating capacity, from being compelled to disclose the source of any news or information, or any news or information procured for communication to the public but which is not so communicated in whole or in part; allowing a court, under certain circumstances, to compel disclosure of specific news or information that was obtained by certain persons for specific purposes; prohibiting certain protections from compelled disclosure from being waived under specific circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to privileged communications.
