SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

6-203.

(a) From among its appointed members, the Board shall elect fa--president, --a--vice--president, --and-a-treasurer OFFICERS: A PRESIDENT, A FIRST VICE PRESIDENT, AND A SECOND VICE PRESIDENT.
6-205.

In addition to the powers and duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board has the following powers and duties:

- (1) To adopt bylaws, rules, and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title;
 - (2) To adopt a seal;
- (3) To establish procedures for licensing apprentices;
- (4) To keep a list of all individuals currently licensed by the Board;
- (5) To investigate any alleged violation of this title;
 - (6) To enforce this title; [and]
- (7) To adopt rules and regulations regarding false and misleading advertising and misrepresentation; $\ensuremath{\mathsf{AND}}$
- (8) TO ANNUALLY INSPECT LICENSED FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENTS AS-DETERMINED-BY-THE-BOARD.
- (b) The Board shall examine all applications for licensure for the practice of mortuary science and shall issue the mortician license to any person who:
