

(i) Meets the qualifications otherwise required by this title for a general license to practice dentistry; and

(ii) Holds a license to practice dentistry from any other state.

(c) The Board may grant a waiver of the examination requirement for a general license to practice dental hygiene under this section only if the applicant:

(1) Pays the application fee required by § 4-304 of this subtitle; and

(2) Provides adequate evidence that the applicant:

(i) Meets the qualifications otherwise required by this title for a general license to practice dental hygiene; and

(ii) Holds a license to practice dental hygiene from any other state.]

4-306.

(A) (1) A DENTIST LICENSED IN ANY OTHER STATE WHO, FOR 5 PRECEDING YEARS, HAS BEEN ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN PRACTICING DENTISTRY SHALL BE GRANTED A LICENSE IN THIS STATE AFTER PASSING AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE BOARD.

(2) A DENTAL HYGIENIST LICENSED IN ANY OTHER STATE WHO, FOR 3 PRECEDING YEARS, HAS BEEN ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN PRACTICING DENTAL HYGIENE SHALL BE GRANTED A LICENSE IN THIS STATE AFTER PASSING AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE BOARD.

(B) (1) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE EXAMINATION AND ANY OTHER REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSURE OF INDIVIDUALS WHO APPLY FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE EXAMINATION AND ANY OTHER REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSURE OF INDIVIDUALS WHO APPLY FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

(C) AN APPLICANT FOR A GENERAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

(1) PAY THE APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY § 4-304 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) PROVIDE ADEQUATE EVIDENCE THAT THE APPLICANT:
