CHAPTER 137

(Senate Bill 261)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Bailiffs - Compensation

FOR the purpose of providing that the rate of compensation for bailiffs in Dorchester County shall be set up by the court and confirmed by the County Commissioners.

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 2-506(a)(10) Annotated Code of Maryland (1984 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-506.

- (a) A bailiff shall receive the compensation provided in this section. Unless otherwise provided, the amount is a per diem sum for each day he attends the circuit court.
- (10) Dorchester County [\$15] AS SET BY THE COURT AND CONFIRMED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
