- (c) Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:
  - (1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
- (2) Pays to the Board a renewal fee equivalent to an annual fee of \$45; and
  - (3) Submits to the Board:
- (i) A renewal application on the form that the Board requires;  $-\frac{1}{2}$
- (ii) Satisfactory evidence of compliance with any continuing education requirements set under this section for license renewal?-AND.

## CHAPTER 154

(Senate Bill 754)

AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations - Dietitians and Nutritionists - Licensing - Experience
