FOR the purpose of granting certain limited immunity from civil liability to certain volunteers providing services or performing duties for a county board of education; creating exceptions for individual liability of certain volunteers under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; providing for the application and construction of this Act; and generally relating to civil liability of certain volunteers working for a county board of education.
