AN ACT concerning

State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners - Injunctive Relief

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners to seek injunctive relief under certain circumstances; providing-that-a-finding-of--the--Board--is prima--facie-evidence-under-certain-circumstances;-providing certain--grounds--for--a--court--to--grant--an---injunction; providing that an injunctive action is not an exclusive remedy; and generally relating to the authority of the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners to seek injunctive relief.
